



New York Trip Rules and Regulations

The Ranger Choir department handbook outlines travel expectations for all participants of the program. All district and school guidelines should be adhered to with the addition of the following items below.

1. School Board policy states that the school is responsible for maintaining appropriate student behavior while attending school or any school sponsored activity. This responsibility carries with it authority to administer consequences for misbehavior. We reserve the right to send students home via the parent's expense in the event of a serious infraction.
2. Be at the appointed places with the necessary equipment at the appointed time.
3. No tobacco products, alcohol, or drug use at any time.
4. School dress code should be followed. Some events will require additional attire requirements. These will be outlined in an updated itinerary.
5. Students are not permitted to enter the room of the opposite gender at any time for any reason.
6. Please refrain from public displays of affection.
7. Be courteous to chaperones and adult sponsors.
8. Curfew given will be strictly enforced.
9. Keep noise in the hotel to a minimum.
10. Students will be responsible for any damages/incidentals/unauthorized purchases at the hotel.
11. All medications must be prescribed unless listed by the parent on the medication section of emergency form.
12. Students must travel in groups of three or more at all times.
